Grounded in social values for the care of the weaker sections of society and serving with a special focus on farmers and women. The organization aims at the uplift and sustainable development of rural and urban poor, and the empowerment of women, through Education, Health, Environment, Watershed, Social awareness, and Community-based rehabilitation programs. The Organization has expertise in Farmers Producers Organization (FPO) and linkages to Women Self Help Groups (SHGs). It has a well-experienced staff, board, and advisers. The organization is certified with Guide Star, Give India, Global Giving and CAF.

OBJECTIVES

The society aims at the upliftment and sustainable development of the Rural Poor, Empowerment of Women, Backward and Minority Communities through Education, Health, and Social Awareness Programmes, development of Watershed Conservation and preservation of soil, forestry, agriculture and community- based Rehabilitation Programmes.

01. Inspection of developmental Activities of NABARD FPOs:

Sri.B.Ravi, DDM - NABARD visited the FPOs promoted by NABARD in Shivamogga District. These FPOs have set up their own input shops, wherein members can buy high-quality seeds, fertilizer, and other inputs at subsidized prices. Some of the FPOs also have a Custom Hiring Center (CHC), where farm machinery is accessible to the farmers. The average crop



productivity was enhanced, as a result of demonstrated crop cultivation techniques and Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) to the FPO farmers. Shareholders of farmers are also increasing day by day. DDM reviewed the FPO and CHC records and also discussed the developmental activities & challenges faced by the FPOs.



02. PMIC (Project Managing and Implementation Committee) Meetings:

For every quarter of the year, the PMIC meeting was held. The meeting was held in the presence of dignitaries of NABARD DDM, JDA-Department of Agriculture, DDH-Department of Horticulture, KVK scientist-UAHS Shivamogga and LDM, Canara Bank Shivamogga. Also, the Director and CEO of the respective FPO were present. The main agenda of the meeting is the progress of the



quarterly review of FPOs of the watershed and other FPOs work performance of the promoting activities and implementation of NABARD and Recommendation by DDM for the grant releases from RO, NABARD.



03. Training to the Leaders and Members of the SHGs

On 15th and 16th of December 2022 two programs training conducted to leaders and members of SHGs held at Ubbenahalli and Kunchenahalli village of Shivamogga the chief guests present were Shri Ravi B. DDM, NABARD, Shimoga and Mr. Yethish M.D. LDM of Canara Bank, Shivamogga the main aim of this training is to provide awareness about regular



group meetings, savings and internal lending and related books of accounts, assessment of SHGs, Informal credit sources, Credit sanction procedures based on the demand of members, timely repayment of loan and maintenance of proper books of accounts, capacity building and SHG Bank Linkages.



04. Watershed Soil & Water Conservation Project:

Chaitanya Rural Development Society taken the watershed-soil and water conservation project and conducted different level of training program under two different projects the main objectives of this program is to manage the natural resources based on watershed principal and/ or by using the Scientific Land Resource Information to improve the



rainfed area land productivity and its production capabilities.

To improve the living status of the people of watershed area and also provide livelihood activities to asset less farmers in the project area through various quality skill based training programme their by providing employment opportunity at their door step. 2,370 farmers get benefited from this program.



05. Promotion of Amruth FPOs in Districts of Shivamogga, Chitradurga, Haveri & Uttar Kannada:

The major work of this year is promotion and establishment of Amruth FPOs in four district in line with the five departments i.e. Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Science, Handlooms & Textiles. In Chitradurga-6, Haveri-13, Uttar Kannada-5, Shivamogga-8 FPOs are promoted and established.

06. Training program for areca farmers under the SCALE project:

This year, we mainly have done the training programs for farmers under the SCALE project for the 4 FPOs i.e. Dhatri, Doddamathali, Kallukoppa, and Ripponpet FPOs. This year we mainly focused on the areca farmers, & gave the training to nearly 2000 farmers. Dr. H. Narayansawmy, Rtd prof, plant pathology Arecanut Research Center Shivamogga, & Amrutha P. Horticulture Officer CRDS Shivamogga, gave the complete information about cultivation practices of Arecanut in the training programs and did the various field inspections thereby trying to solve the farmer's problems in the field levels.



This project aims to strengthen Small & Marginal farmer to improve agricultural production & marketing and by building capacities for employment & enterprise development.

Along with this, we by building provide the IEC materials to the farmers which include complete POP of Arecanut and provide the CHC service through these FPOs, which was very helpful to the farmers, by the timely availability of Farm machines like dhobi and sprayers all those

things at a marginal rate. This Project is a CSR initiative by

Dharampal Satyapal Ltd, Noida. They visited these FPOs and reviewed all those activities and CHC records and also communicated with the farmers. We are very grateful to the DS group for giving us a chance to implement this project and giving service to the farmers.



07. Covid Health Kit Distribution at Rural Areas of Shivamogga

In the month of August 2022, Chaitanya voluntarily distributed the Covid Health Kit under the Women and Child Development Department and Pooja charitable trust



organized an appreciation and support campaign for Aganavadi ASHA workers and rural people of Shivamogga, rural areas of seven districts, there were have been 3500 Covid Health Kit distributed donors of the health kit sponsored with USAID New Delhi.



08. Workshop on Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)

In the month of September 2022, conducted a state level workshop on JJM held at Banashankari Zilla Panchayath, Bangalore and Karwar with the presence of chief guest ISRADirector Sheetal Singh, Mr. Jagdeesh, Mr. Ramanjanaya, State Coordinator and Mr. Dinkar Jadav K. JJM Project Coordinator, Chaitanya Rural Development Society, Shivamogga. The main objective and aim of the workshop are to Importance of safe water and hygiene, Water Quality



monitoring and



surveillance, Village Action Plan, Overseeing of water supply infrastructure during construction by the community, GP as a Utility for decentralized management of drinking water system, Status of Implementation.

09. Annual general body meeting of FPOs:

Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) of each FPO was held in the presence of as a chief guest Sri B. Ravi DDM, NABARD, Shivamogga. Board of directors & CEO & shareholders of respective FPOs were present.

The main objective of the AGM is to discuss the financial details-such as the balance sheet and budget and get member approval for key decisions taken by the board, and challenges of FPO. These FPOs circulated an annual report with highlights of the activities of the FPO in the year. It also listed all the



licenses and certificates that the FPO has and why they were required. This was helpful to building awareness among the FPO members about the various regulatory compliances that the FPO adhered to and the services that the FPO offered. It presents the image of the FPO as a professional organization working for the benefit of the farmer members but also operating in a business-like and professional company within the regulatory framework.



10. Inauguration of Arecanut and Black Pepper CHC tools in FPO:

This year we have done another important activity, by providing the Areca and Black Pepper Dehusking Machine to the Dhatri FPO under the SCALE project. Shri. T. Ramesh CGM, NABARD- RO, Bangalore inaugurates the program. Totally we provided the 12 Farm equipment to the FPOs. The main objective of donating CHC service is to supply farm implements to small and marginal farmers at subsidized



rates on hire. To facilitate timeliness in farm operations and efficient use of inputs promotes the adoption of climate-resilient practices and technologies by farmers because of



the availability of appropriate machines at reasonable hiring charges. Promotes an increase in cropping intensity wherever feasible.



11. Inauguration of Kallukoppa Rural Mart:

In October month of this year, we inaugurated the Rural Mart in Hanagerekatte village, Kallukoppa FPO. It was inaugurated by the chief guest Smt. Deepa Pillai, NABARD DGM- Bangalore and Shri Ravi B DDM, NABARD- Shimoga, Sri Srinivas and Sri Prakash Naik Consultant - NABARD

Bangaluru were present. The main intention of the establishment of Rural Mart is to provide market access but also help in promoting entrepreneurship among producers and SHGs and provide a marketing platform for SHGs to sell their Agri-Horti and spices crops products and also use the opportunity for economic development by ensuring the continuity, quality and quantity of local goods for local as well as national customers.



12. NABARD - Village Level Program (VLP)

Six VLP programs conducted in the month of November 2022 held at Karehalli, Bhadravathi Taluk, Holaluru, Pillayangiri, B. Birnahalli of Shivamogga Taluk, Jekkin Koppa, Shikaripura Taluk, and Kallukoppa Shimoga Taluk. The program was held in the presence of Shri. Ravi B. DDM, NABARD, Shimoga. The VLPs program was conducted at ground level with the support of NABARD, which helped in the opening of SHGs accounts, their credit linkage and regular loan repayments. It lays emphasis on



participatory planning, and convergence of various development programs to bring about the overall development of villagers, it also focuses on financial inclusion and also to develop the selected village in an integrated manner. This would include economic development, infrastructure development and other aspects for development.

13. Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Rural Energy and Development (MGIRED) for SHGs:

Five days workshop for on 10th to 14th of October was conducted Sponsored by MGIRED for SHG women at Mother Theresa Auditorium Shimoga multipurpose social service society (R). The main agenda of this program is MGIRED are providing training over 5 days to 33 members of SHGs under GPLFs (Gram Panchayat Level Federation). The training program involved in Solid waste management, categories of



segregation, management of wet and dry waste, domestic hazardous waste, and terrace gardening and exposure visits at Chiranthana Green technology center, exposure and demonstrations of Biofuel-park, Rainwater Harvesting and use of Solar Energy JNNCE College Shivamogga.

14. Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana 2.0 (WDC-PMKSY 2.0)

Chaitanya was awarded for the implementing awareness generation, orientation and mobilization of people, capacity building and formation of community institutions and



training and orientation of project functionaries under Watershed Development Component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana 2.0 (WDC-PMKSY 2.0) in Hirenelluru Village, Kadur Taluk of Chikmagalur District in Karnataka state.



There are 24 FPOs in Shimoga district. 30 Amruth FPOs in different districts. All this was handled by Chaitanya.

We have done the training programs for 2000 farmers and 40 Model farmers. On inter cropping on Pepper

We provided the CHC service to more than 500 farmers from each FPO at a marginal rate.
